

VINTAGE DIRT Vintage Dirt Bike Festival Wandering – "Paynes Find" 13th-14th July 2024

Open to anyone with an offroad bike that fits any of the classes on offer. Club membership not necessary, no licences required.

A weekend designed to get old bikes out on track in non competitive casual ride sessions over 2 days. With 2 ride areas catering to Vintage and Classic Motocross and Vinduro. All eras of Vintage and Classic motocross and Vinduro from the 50s through to 2003. This will be a showcase of Vintage Off Road Motorcycling in Western Australia with both riding and Show Shine opportunities.

Venue Location

The Wandering "Paynes Find" track is located approximately 10km from the Wandering townsite heading towards Narrogin on the Wandering-Pingelly Rd. Approximately 1.5 hrs from Perth. Show and Shine

Show and Shine display on Sunday 14th July catering to all Classic offroad motorcycle classes (MX, Trial, Speedway). No fee to enter, just roll your bike into the show and shine area before 11am.

Held between 1100 and 1300 with judging during this period. Trophies for best in show and peoples choice best in show. Prize packs for best racer, best original and best barn find original.

Tracks

- Classic Motocross: 1.6km long, Vintage friendly farm track
- Vinduro: 6km loop with easy, medium and hard section cut offs

Both tracks are run independent of each other. Vinduro will run all day on both days subject to a maximum number of riders at any one time, come and go as you please.

Ride Sessions

Classes run on the day will depend on the entrants for each class. Classes may be changed on the day, expected format Pre '75, Pre '85, Period 20, Sidecars (15mins), Juniors* (15mins).

For motocross each designated session will be approximately 30-40mins long to facilitate casual ride sessions where riders can come and go from their session as they please subject to maximum rider limit. Vinduro will be open all day subject to a maximum number of riders at any one time, come and go as you please.

This includes ride and licence fee for both days. No separate competition licence required. Motorcycling Australia Ride Park Waiver to be signed. To ease sign on please have the waiver filled in before attending for the weekend.

For those arriving after riders brief ensure you have received a briefing from an official when you sign on before entering your next designated ride session. All participants are to sign on and receive an arm band prior to entering any of the ride areas.

Scrutineering/Riding Gear requirements

All bikes to comply with the 2024 Manual of Motorcycle sport. Bars ends to be plugged, no loose wheel/steering/frame bearings/bushes, throttle to be self returning, sidestands removed for Motocross and secured in closed position for Vinduro, footpegs to be hinged, no loose spokes and brakes working. Scrutineering is the responsibility of the entrant.

Riding gear as per the 2024 Manual of Motorcycle sport. Helmets with appropriate standard label, Boots, Nylon pants, gloves, long sleeve top and goggles.

- I also agree to indemnify the Provider and any directors or officers of the Provider or any volunteer or employee of the Provider who is involved with organising the Recreational Activity against any claims actions, suits, proceedings or liabilities of any kind in respect of any personal injury or death suffered by me.
- I also agree that the liability of the Provider for any personal injury that may result from the supply of the Recreational Services (as defined below) that may be suffered by me is excluded.
- I acknowledge the onus of presenting a safe machine remains my sole responsibility throughout the duration of the recreational activity and I may be declined permission to participate should my machine be deemed unsafe.
- I acknowledge that it is my personal responsibility to wear appropriate riding attire at all times throughout the duration of the recreational activity.
